PRAYER DIRECTIVES (Week #1)

During this first week of prayer, we are directing our prayers in the form of “praise and worship.” The scriptural text will be found in **Psalms 100** with the key focus on **verse 4**.

1. Joyfully enter into prayer audibly offering sacrifices of praise and thanksgiving to God. Make a joyful noise unto the Lord. Minister unto His with a glad heart.
2. Set your focus upon God only and request that He receive your praise and worship; ask that it will be an acceptable offering and sweet in His nostrils.
3. Allow your spirit to be free in worship through the utterances of your lips, the waving of your hands, and the release of your total being in His presence.
4. Thank God, Exalt His name (Jesus); Think on His goodness to you and those whom you love; Bless Him for His mercy and love; Thank His for salvation that is free to all; Clap with your hands; Dance with your feet; Shout hallelujah; Thank Him for what He is doing in you and will do; Give God all of your heart, mind, soul, and strength in praise.
5. Read the attached scriptures and ask God for understanding and a deeper revelation of His Word.
6. Sanctify your thoughts asking God for His mind and His thoughts. Expect the thoughts of God for a new level of praise and a new level of worship. Be not surprised if you experience new tongues and uninhibited levels of worship. Go higher as God leads you into new realms during worship.
7. Anticipate God to meet you. Invite Him in and expect Him!
8. Invite the heavenly host of angels to join with you in worship.
9. Yield in obedience to the move and direction of the Holy Ghost without question.

PRAYER DIRECTIVES (Week #1)

Psalm 100 - King James Version (KJV)

- ¹ Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands.

- ³ Know *and* fully recognize with gratitude that the LORD Himself is God; It is He who has made us, not we ourselves and we are His. *We are* His people and the sheep of His pasture.
- ⁴ Enter His gates with a song of thanksgiving and His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, bless *and* praise His name.
- ⁵ For the LORD is good; His mercy *and* lovingkindness are everlasting, His faithfulness endures to all generations.
