PRAYER DIRECTIVES (Week #2 Monday, July 17th thru Sunday, July 23rd)

During this **Second week of prayer**, we are directing our prayer to the topic of **“National & Personal Repentance”**. This area of prayer is very broad; however, the spirit of God will direct your prayers beyond that which is listed in these directives.

Repentance is the reviewing of one's actions and feeling contrition or regret for past wrongs. It is involving a commitment to personal change and the resolve to live a more responsible and Godly life.

1. Wash me, Oh Lord.....Pray **Psalms 51**.
2. Receive God's forgiveness and forgive yourself. Release the burdens that you have carried and receive God's everlasting love; enter into His loving arms with the assurance that you are totally restored. Thank God for mercy.
3. We repent for our nation. We repent for mismanagement and every ungodly decision that has brought us to this tedious point in time. We pray mercy and send **help** from the sanctuary. We pray for the upcoming elections of community leaders, city officials, and state officials throughout this nation. We curse every ungodly attempt to gain or be placed in leadership and agree with and set in place God's chosen to occupy every seat of authority.
4. We repent for those who serve in leadership in these seven cultural mountains: business, government, media, arts and entertainment, education, the family, and religion. Forgive us Lord for not fulfilling with integrity our assigned tasks as leaders in these areas of influence. We pray that godly, Spirit-filled men and women will rise up and be leaders in these areas. We cast down the spirit of haughtiness and pride and decree the manifestation of Godliness.
5. We repent for our prayerlessness. Lord, teach us how to pray, **always!**

6. Scriptural Study Points:

- a. For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death. (2 Cor. 7:10)
- b. The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. (II Peter 3:9)
- c. If that nation, against whom I have pronounced, turn from their evil, I will repent of the evil that I thought to do unto them. (Jeremiah 18:8)
- d. Therefore say unto the house of Israel, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Repent, and turn yourselves from your idols; and turn away your faces from all your abominations. (Ezekial 14:6)
- e. Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand. (Matthew 3:2)
- f. I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish. (Luke 13:3)
- g. Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord. (Acts 3:19)
- h. Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee. (Acts 8:22)
- i. And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent..(Acts 17:30)
- j. Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou repent. (Revelation 2:5)
- k. Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee. (Rev. 3:3)
- l. As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent. (Rev. 3:19)
